- The meeting was called to order at 10:00 am by President Wayne Rickman.
- The minutes of the 7/9/21 Board meeting were approved.

Treasurer's Report: Michael St. John

 Checking account and endowment accounts are robust due to lack of activity in spending because of the Covid situation.

General Interest Curriculum Committee: Steve Gordy

· No report since semester has not begun yet.

Technology Interest Committee: Raleigh Daniel

- · No report on classes yet.
- Technical articles for Aiken Standard's Prime Living are all complete and ready to submit for the rest of the semester (August thru December).

Publicity Committee Report: Jim Tisaranni (with additional input from Michael St. John)

- Two ads are being placed in Aiken Standard, on this Sunday (8-8) and another next Sunday.
- WRDW has offered fifty-seven 15 second spots to be shown during Wheel of Fortune timeslot for one month for a \$1500 charge. They would shoot the video, which will be a voice-over type. The board voted to accept the offer. Michael will script the video.
- The fall schedule and a complete copy of the catalog have been loaded onto the webpage.
- Doug will distribute the Spiral newsletter via the public email list maintained by Jim. It will also be added to the CLL website.
- It was decided to use CLL as the acronym for the organization, so that we are all using the same one.
- The need for visual resources for marketing was emphasized. There is a need for pictures of classes and instructors to be used with press releases, website, Spiral and articles. We currently do not have a person to take the photos.

Old Business

- Catalog Status
 Catalog is projected to be delivered the first weekend of August.
- Open House

Open house will be set for August 17, 9:00 am to noon. Volunteers are needed to work the vehicle parking sticker table, the membership cards table, and someone is needed to help answer phones in office (since most staff is helping out with open house). Actual registration for CLL students will be done by USCA staff. Raleigh will ask for technical volunteers at his meeting and David will send out an email asking for volunteers from liaisons.

New Business

Proposal for adding Assistant chair persons for the committees

After extensive debate, the proposal was changed to allow chair-elects (chosen by their committee or their

chair) to be encouraged to attend all board meetings along with the committee chair (or in place of the chair when he had to be absent). The chair-elect could participate in the meetings, but would not have a vote unless he was representing the committee when the chair was absent.

 Proposal for adding two board positions from the public at large

The board voted to add the positions. Any board member can nominate a candidate for either of the positions. The elected board member would be a voting member of the board.

Jim Tisaranni nominated Donna Wesby, who is manager of radio station SHOUT 94.7 (WAAW). The board agreed that it would be a good choice. He will get in touch with her and see if she is interested.

 Proposal for adding a volunteer committee with a committee chair

Nancy Hughes was nominated as chair for the committee. Debate followed, but resolution was not voted on due to time constraints. Proposal will be addressed again at next meeting.

Miscellaneous

- CLL will follow USCA's protocols for dealing with Covid.
- Masks not required at present, but may be encouraged.

- There will be no online classes.
- Michael will determine which member benefits are unique to CLL and which are available to seniors at large.
- Bylaws updates are to be recorded by secretary when they are voted in by board.
- Regular Board meetings for the fall semester 2021 will be on the first Friday of each month, August through November, at 10:00 am in room 102.
