season with you.



Surprise Guest Speakers at World War I Course

One of the features of courses offered by the Center of LifeLong Learning (CLL) is the opportunity for unique class format and content.

Robert Anzuoni is director of the US Army Signal Corps Museum at Fort Gordon, near Augusta Georgia, and a veteran of the US 82nd Airborne Division. His current CLL course is "World War I: The Great War". The first class session covered French and German political and diplomatic situations, military strategies, available resources, and mobilizations at the beginning of the war. Anzuoni invited two guest speakers, French Army Lt. Colonel Nicolos Pierson and German Army Lt. Colonel Sascha Blankenburg, to provide indepth historical information and insight on these topics from the viewpoints of their respective countries. Lt. Colonels Pierson and Blankenburg, who are good friends, currently serve their nations as military liaison officers to the US Army Signal Corps. Both are currently stationed at Fort Gordon.
