# History in Headstones Course Delved into Baseball History

Jeanmarie Bronson just wrapped up the latest in her popular *History in Headstones* series of courses in November. This course centered on the "Blacksox" World Series scandal of 1919, and along the way branched into early baseball history as well as local baseball connections.

In one session she invited a couple of local baseball experts to speak. Milledge Murray told about Joe Jackson, and of his connection to South Carolina. "Shoeless" Joe was one of the Chicago White Sox

players involved in the 1919 scandal. Lamar Garrard gave the class information about baseball in the CSRA and shared stories of minor league players in our region who had gone on to play in the majors.

Jeanmarie turned part of the final session to UofSC Baseball Coach Mike Holder, who talked about the Pacer baseball program. As part of his talk he brought in several of his players to illustrate various versions of the team's home and away uniforms and explained when each would be used.
