Farewell, Dr. James Kauffman

The Academy is saddened by the loss of USCA Professor Emeritus Dr. James F. Kauffman, who passed away in his home on December 17 at the age of 81.

Dr. Kauffman's career with the university spanned from 1976 until his retirement as Distinguished Professor Emeritus of Education in 2005. During his career, he held the positions of Associate Chancellor and Dean of Students. In the 1978 Jim volunteered to coach the Pacer Baseball team when the school was considering dropping the sport and is credited with spearheading the movement that made the baseball program what it is today. He also served as USCA Athletic Director from 1980 to 1984, and In 2014 he was inducted into the USCA Athletic Hall of Fame.

Jim was the son of Dr. Earl Kauffman, one of the individuals most responsible for the founding of the Academy for Lifelong Learning at USCA in 1989*.

In memory of his father, Jim established an endowment to fund the annual Earl F. Kauffman Recognition Day held every spring by the Academy. Each year a deserving individual or group is recognized for exceptional contribution to the Academy and its goals at a banquet to which all Academy members are invited. Dr. Kauffman last attended the festivities in 2015, but was unable to attend this past spring due to health issues.

Dr. Kauffman was a staunch supporter at USCA of the program begun by his father, and the Academy mourns his passing.
