President's Message

Welcome back!

The Academy for Lifelong Learning Fall semester begins on September 6. We have a diverse selection of 29 courses this fall plus 2 trips and special events, so there is sure to be something for everyone. Our fall semester ends the middle of December. Spring 2018 semester begins in mid-January 2018.

Yes, course registration is still open. You can print the registration form from the course catalog on our web page <u>www.aikenlearning.org</u> or register in person at Abby Grizzle's office in Business & Education room 113. If you have already registered for classes, you should have received an email confirmation. If not, please contact Abby. We currently have waitlisted names for a few of our courses, as shown on our website's Catalog page. If a course you have registered for is shown as waitlisted on your registration form, please do not attend unless notified by Abby Grizzle from the Continuing Education office. Two of our previous waitlisted courses have been moved to larger rooms, so be sure to check our web page for the most current information.

A few important things to remember as the semester progresses:

Park only between the white lines in the lots (or a handicapped slot [if applicable]). There are no parking stickers this year for the white lines—if you park between yellow lines, you run the risk of being ticketed.

Check your email daily. This is the only efficient way to notify you when a class has been relocated or we need to convey additional information.
