When Spring term registration begins, you will be able to go online to pay your semester's fees

and register for your choice of courses and events from the comfort of your own home.

Registration for the Spring 2018 term begins December 18 at 9:00 AM. No early registrations will be accepted.

If you're not yet ready to take the online registration plunge you can still register the old way via mailing or hand-delivering the registration form from the published catalog once registration opens. Note that these submissions must be hand-entered by USCA one at a time, whereas online registrations go into the system instantly.

Parking Decals Now Available From Continuing Education Office

USCA campus police requires all students, **including Academy members**, to have a current campus parking permit decal mounted in their vehicle windshields when parking in the campus parking lots. Violators are subject to fines or having their vehicle towed.

If you still need a parking decal, you may now get one from the Continuing Education office – you no longer need to go to the campus Police station. To get your parking decal:

- 1. Obtain the USCA Parking Decal Form from one of the following:
 - The **DOCUMENTS** page on our website.
 - The Spring 2018 Catalog
 - The Continuing Education office, Business and Education Building, Room 113.
- 2: Fill out the Parking Decal Form and either:

Bring your completed form with your vehicle registration and drivers license to *Open Enrollment Days* in Business and Education Computer Lab, Room 130, Monday December 18 and Tuesday December 18, 9:00 am to 2:00 pm

OR

Call the USCA Continuing Education office (803.641.3563) for an appointment, then at your appointed time take your completed form with your vehicle registration and drivers license to Business and Education Building, Room 113.

NOTE: If you already have your decal, you do not need to get a new one until you reach the expiration date shown on the decal.

Harriet, Kathy, and Doug C will meet with Abby and/or Karen immediately following the Curriculum Committee meeting on Nov 7 to schedule class rooms, meeting times and dates for the classes so that this information can be put into the catalog and Active Network. The target date for sending the catalog to the printer is November 15, with a projected release date of December 4. If we meet these dates, registration will begin December 11.

Rachel's submission to the October *Mature Times* supplement to the *Aiken Standard* emphasized the courses being taught by popular returning instructors.

Class Cancellation Policy

Our policy as clarified last month is that all class sessions, on-campus or off, will be canceled on days when USCA cancels classes due to weather or other emergency. Discussion carried over from last month regarding cancellation of off-campus trips and events when USCA cancels classes, recognizing that on-campus situations may not apply off-campus. No definitive decision was reached and Doug W will bring proposed wording to a future board for discussion and approval.

Kauffman Award

Doug C requested the Board members to think about candidates for Spring 2018 and submit their names to him.

Active Network Implementation / Online Registration

Continuing Education has used the new Active Network class management system for its own external offerings this semester and is satisfied everything is up and running satisfactorily. Online registration has gone well.

The Academy will begin using Active Network for the upcoming Spring semester, including using it to register online. We will still publish a full catalog for now and accept paper registration forms from the catalog for those unable or unwilling to register online.

Joel is to set up a dummy registration page for Board members to use to become familiar with the process and so better understand what we need to communicate to the membership about the new registration system.

Our intent is to preload only our current Fall 2017 registrants into the new system for purposes of email management, and of course Spring registrants will be there automatically as well. Any non-registrants who wish to continue to receive communications from the Academy will need to proactively request that they be added into the new system. Doug W will communicate this information via the website and the November and December issues of *The Spiral*.

Parking Decals

Campus police have begun issuing parking tickets with an associated \$70 fine for student cars (including Academy members' cars) parked on campus without USCA parking pass decals in place on their windshields. Academy members can have these tickets voided by visiting the campus police office. The intent is to have an up-to-date database of registrants and license plate numbers to facilitate locating the owner in case of emergency. Abby emailed a form to the membership which can be filled out and taken to the campus police office to obtain the decal. The form has also been placed on the Documents page of the website and will be inserted in the upcoming Spring course catalog.
