Fall Registration Going Strong

Registration for the Academy's Fall 2019 term opened on August 19 and the response has been phenomenal. Nearly 200 students registered in just the first two days

As this is being written in the waning days of August, it's still 1-1/2 weeks before classes start and we have over 230 registrants.. A number of classes quickly filled and people have signed up on class waiting lists. The Academy is working with UofSC Aiken to relocate popular classes to larger rooms and add additional sessions to reduce or eliminate the wait lists. MINUTES

Minutes of the prior Board meeting, held March 25, 2019, were approved.

TREASURERS REPORT - Joel Aitchison

The mailing address for the Security Federal checking account has been updated and Joel is now receiving the monthly statements.

Several of our teacher payments are still being processed by Columbia. We have a comfortable balance that can handle these with no problem.

Doug asked Joel to assemble a report categorizing our expenses for the 2018-2019 academic year and use it as a basis for a proposed budget for next year. Joel will distribute this to the Board via email since there likely will not be another Board meeting this semester.

CURRICULUM COMMITTEE REPORT – Harriet Haynes for Kathy Rachick

There are about 30 classes being finalized for next semester, with most of the information for the catalog having been submitted. Scheduling is targeted for early May to lock up our classrooms before the system opens their availability up more widely. Four Events/Trips are being planned.
