During these trying times, The Office of External Programs, Continuing Education, and Conferences has missed seeing everyone! We hope that you and your loved ones have stayed well.

The entire University of South Carolina Aiken campus is moving forward with resuming face-to-face classes this fall. In addition, many of our classes are also being offered online for those who prefer to avoid a face-to-face classroom environment.

To help ensure the health and safety of the Pacer community, precautions are being put in place in adherence with the strict guidelines of the Center for Disease Control (www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov) and closely following notifications about the virus from the Governor's Office.

- ▶ On our part, class size has been reduced by 50% to assure social spacing, classroom surfaces are being sanitized between classes, and hand disinfectant is readily available throughout the campus.
- ▶ Those attending classes on campus will be expected to abide by certain precautionary measures. Please be sure to wear a face covering, wash your hands often, maintain social spacing, and if you are not feeling well, please stay home to ensure we keep our campus as healthy as possible.

Fall Academy About to Get Underway

Your Academy is about to come roaring back from its Covid-19 forced shut down last spring. The catalogs are out and registration has been opened since mid-August.

Most courses are being offered both in-class and simultaneously online via the internet. You choose which version of each course you want when registering.

Due to Covid guidelines, University class sizes have been reduced by 50%. The resulting need for more University class sections has put a strain on class-room availability. This semester we will not have the luxury we've enjoyed in the past of being able to reschedule into larger classrooms or to add additional sections when popular Academy classes fill. Please note that if the in-class option you want is full, in most cases you can still choose the online version.

Online Classes a New Venture for Academy

This semester marks the debut of online classes at the Academy. Those who register for the online versions of these courses will be able to participate in the live sessions being held on campus via the internet. The online sessions will be accessible via computers using Microsoft Edge or Google Chrome as their browsers, or via the Microsoft Teams app that is available for iOS, Windows, and Android. Registrants will be emailed links they can use to connect to the sessions prior to the beginning of the class.

As this is a new undertaking for all concerned please be patient if there are some initial glitches.

Registration in Progress

It is anticipated that Covid concerns will likely reduce the number of registrants this semester, yet seventy people registered on the first day when registration opened up August 18. As this is written at the end of August well over one hundred have registered. For the courses offered both in-class and online, slightly over half of the registrations so far have been for the online version. Individual course registrations range from 0% to 65% online.

The first classes start September 8, so there's still time to get registered and not miss anything.

Line Dancing Moves Up Three Weeks

Those wanting to do some boot scootin' won't have to wait as long as they thought. The 6-week *Line Dancing* class has been rescheduled to start on September 21 instead of October 12.
