The meeting was called to order at 2:02 pm by Harriet Haynes.

The minutes of the 1/11/21 Board meeting were approved.

<u>Treasurer's Report:</u> available as a handout. <u>Curriculum Committee: David Tavernier</u>

- Reported that evaluation forms from fall classes were uniformly positive and contained many suggestions for future classes.
- 2. Discussed two "Great Decisions" classes, one at Aiken Public Library and ours. Possible effort to combine them so as not to overlap or conflict. David will follow up with this. (Note: on 2/18 David reported that John Karas, who formerly presented this program at the Chicago Public Library, will handle Great Decisions in the Fall semester and going forward. He will not present at the library or

the museum and will try to bring former attendees to our program.)

Old Business:

- Karen announced that Kim Steele will be the new treasurer.
- New lapel type microphones were ordered and have come in. A clock has been ordered for room 124.
- Steve and David reported on their respective ideas for fund raising events. One would be a book sale at USCA in late fall; the other a gala at the Constantine House in September. Details on both will be reported at the March meeting.
- 4. McGrath Merger:
 - 5. Name Change committee: Nancy reported that per USCA there would be no conflict with existing LLL documents or endowment if there is an LLL name change. A draft logo created by Aubrey was circulated. Board agreed to use name "Kauffman-McGrath Lifelong Learning Academy". Karen noted this needs to be checked with the University since "USCA" would also appear on the logo. Suggestion that size of lantern be tweaked to allow for more open space.
 - Web Page/Spiral Magazine: Doug referred board to his 1/31 email which recommended that: both website and newsletter functions should be continued, each serving for the combined organization.

A single combined website should be created to replace the current sites, with Jim Brown as the Webmaster; Doug Wilson would be the Newsletter editor. Both will cross-train to be able to assist and back up the other.

Doug noted that our by-laws require a monthly newsletter. Eventually there would be a common website.
