### **UPDATE ON SCHEDULING ISSUES**

This is a special edition of *The Spiral* dealing with the scheduling problems the Center for Lifelong Learning has encountered this semester.

The Center staff deeply regrets these problems. We know and appreciate that you can not always change your schedule when we change ours, and we are very aware of the confusion and inconvenience this has caused many of our members. The Center and USC Aiken have been working very hard to resolve these issues and to achieve a stable schedule.

# SCHEDULE CONFLICTS IN THE PUBLISHED CATALOG

As was previously mentioned in the *The Spiral*, numerous classroom conflicts were identified in the Fall 2022 catalog as printed.

As we scrambled to hurriedly remedy these problems, fixing one conflict sometimes created a new conflict somewhere else. This resulted in the release of several cycles of changing and contradictory information on our website, the registration system, and *The Spiral*.

We now have the schedule changes in place to eliminate all classroom assignment conflicts for the rest of the semester. All outlets for our data have been brought into agreement with this revised schedule:

- Online calendar on CLL website

Further, new calendar-based procedures are being put in place to do a better job of schedule management in the future..

## CLASSROOM SIZE LIMITATIONS AND WAIT-LISTS

The USC Aiken Continuing Education Department is housed in the Business and Education (B&E) Building. This year the Department has set aside B&E 144, which has a capacity of 40 seats, for the exclusive use of the Center for Lifelong Learning. More than 40 people wish to enroll in many of our more popular classes,

however, and under this system our ability to move to other larger classrooms has become much more limited. We are actively working with USC Aiken administration to find a better solution for our capacity needs.

In the meanwhile, for several courses with significant wait lists, we have been able to add repeat course sections using our available classroom space to accommodate more people. This staff is working hard to find openings for as many wait listed people as possible.

As a reminder: A course's wait list is what tells the Center when we need to pursue accommodating a larger number of students for the course. If you opt not to register for a course you would like to take because it is already wait listed the Center has no way to gauge the demand for the course. When you register for a class that is already wait listed, you are not charged for the class unless a space for you becomes available and you agree to take it when offered.
