Our Fall Session of courses for the Center will end this month. I hope that you were able to take all the courses that you wanted to take. On that very subject, a few weeks ago, one of our students happened to mention to me that there was a course she really wanted to take during the current session but was unable to do so because it conflicted with a regularly scheduled weekly activity. She was happy to hear that we are working with the instructor to offer this course again in a future semester but on a different day of the week. Dr. Daniel Heimmermann assumed the role of USCA's fifth Chancellor in 2021. He replaced Dr. Sandra Jordan, who had taught several art history classes for us. In October Dr. Heimmermann continued this tradition.

With an academic background in

early-modern French history, the Chancellor presented a talk on the French Revolution and the Napoleonic Era. These events had far reaching effects, not only on France, but on the mores and governments of France's European neighbors and much of the rest of the world. He managed to make history come alive for a large audience in Penland 106.

We hope to have the opportunity of offering more classes from the Chancellor in the future.
