As in the past, we will be offering refreshments during your registration visit.

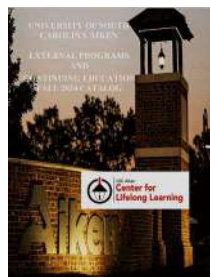
I, along with our board members and volunteers, look forward to seeing you on the 13th.

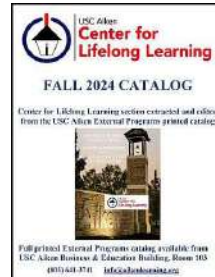

Fall 2024 Registration Opens August 13

Online Registration

Registering online also begins 9:00 am August 13. Go to aikenlearning.org/online.html in your web browser. Payment is by credit card only.

Walk-in registrations will be accepted at USC Aiken Business and Education Building, Room 104. Bring your drivers license and auto registration in with you to the Open House so that we can both sign you up and issue your campus parking pass all in one visit.

Processing of mailed-in registrations begins. Mail your completed registration form from the catalog or website to the address on the form. Credit card is the only payment method accepted for mail-in registrations.

We regret that registrations may no longer be taken over the phone.
