The Center Loses a Dedicated Volunteer

A long term volunteer with many years of service to what is now the Center for Lifelong Learning passed away on July 27.

Dave Emory was an early CLL volunteer, going clear back to the early days of the Aiken Chapter of



SeniorNet which provided information and training for the then-new field of personal computers that was blooming in the late 1990's. SeniorNet in Aiken later morphed into the McGrath Computer Center, which in turn became part of today's Center for Lifelong Learning, and Dave continued to help with all of them. At age 89, Dave was the last of the original "Geezer Geeks" that installed, serviced, and generally took care of the computers used in the various iterations of the organization. In that time Dave also served as a coach in many of the computer classes taught by the Center and its predecessors.

Dave died from injuries sustained in an automobile collision on the Robert Bell Parkway in the vicinity of USC Aiken on July 24. Services for David. L. Emory were held at Aiken First Baptist Church on August 13.
