

## Helene Shuts Down USC Aiken and Center for Lifelong Learning for Over a Week.

Hurricane Helene came ashore in the Florida Panhandle at 11:30 pm, Thursday September 24 as a Category 4 hurricane, the strongest ever to hit that region since record keeping began. The storm raged north through Georgia on Friday. It's storm center passed well west of Aiken, but its destructive northeast quadrant still battered the Aiken area with many inches of rain, gale force winds and tornadoes, along the way leaving a broad band of destruction in its wake. An unprecedented number of trees were downed, taking electric lines with them and leaving many thousands of people with no power. By Sunday evening nearly a third of South Carolina's residents were without electric service for a third straight day.

Heavy rain started in the Aiken area on Thursday September 24 in advance of the storm, causing USC Aiken to heed government warnings and cancel classes for Friday. Helene's full fury battered Aiken and the surrounding area in the early morning hours on Friday. When storm damage was assessed and the massive cleanup was begun the shutdown was quickly extended through Tuesday the following week and eventually to the end of that week. As this is being written, USC Aiken is expected to return to normal operation on Monday, October 7. Latest status updates are available on the school's website, **usca.edu.**
