Recovering from Tropical Storm Helene

Tropical Storm Helene thrashed through the Aiken area in late September leaving record destruction in its wake. The USC Aiken campus closed Friday September 27



and did not open again until Monday October 7. All Center for Lifelong Learning class sessions during the downtime were postponed until they each could be rescheduled.

All told, we lost 6 days of classroom time, involving 21 class sessions. Curriculum Committee Volunteers immediately sprang into action to contact instructors to arrange for dates and times to make up the lost sessions. This was no easy task as the length of the shutdown was extended twice involving more and more sessions, and make ups had to be wedged in around the pre-existing class schedule. Disruption of electrical, telephone, and internet services complicated the process. Proposed make up dates could not be confirmed with the University until the campus came back to life on October 7, and even then efforts to reach instructors were still ongoing.

Of the 19 affected courses, *Excel 102* was about to be canceled anyway due to low enrollment. Declining attendance allowed *Brain and Body Fitness* sections A and B to be combined going forward for their remaining sessions. *Line Dancing* was postponed an additional week due to an unresolved electrical outage at the Shrine facility. Storm aftermath in Edgefield also caused instructor Justin Guy to push back his *Seizing Power* course scheduled to start October 17 until next semester. All of the postponed classes have been rescheduled, most already having been made up in October with a few remaining in November. Those registered for affected courses have been contacted with updates.

Recovering from Helene involved a lot of frenzied activity on the part of a few dedicated volunteers and the External Programs staff, and your Editor tips his hat to them in appreciation.
